Purpose

The purpose of the Meter Technician is to manage, maintain and improve the meter reading and asset management process. This role ensures accurate and reliable metering operations, supporting critical infrastructure, business management operations and customer service. Pay is commensurate with experience, skill, and productivity.

Requirements

- Required high school diploma or equivalent.
- Required Class C driver's license and an excellent driving record.
- Required experience in meter reading, data management or similar roles.
- Preferred 5 years' experience working in water operations or construction.
- Preferred TCEQ Class C water operations license.
- **Safety-sensitive** position responsible for the proper storage and handling of hazardous materials. Preemployment and random drug screening is required.

Responsibilities

Primary Duties

- Read meters via Automated Meter Reading (AMR) and manual methods.
- Transfer files between the billing system and the meter reading system.
- Analyze usage trends to prioritize meter change-outs.
- Test meter accuracy, troubleshoot unusual readings, and perform meter data extractions.
- Disconnect, reconnect, and remove meters.
- Prioritize and efficiently conduct meter replacements.
- Provide technical support and training to staff on meter reading systems.
- Independently investigate meter system anomalies by directly contacting meter technical support.
- Learn and apply new technology, including GNS use for GIS tracking of system assets.
- Cross-train to support and back-up GIS technician.
- Other duties as assigned to ensure superior product and service quality.

Physical Demands

- Work outdoors in all weather conditions.
- Safely use hazardous equipment and chemicals.
- Requires frequent physical effort, including standing, bending and reaching on wet and unlevel ground.
